At SMP, we want all children to become fluent, confident and expressive readers who have both the skills and the will to read effectively. We follow the RWI programme.

What do we do?

Read Write Inc. Phonics

Read Write Inc. phonics for:

-Nursery (Summer term) to Year 3 (for individual children)

Read Write Inc. Fresh Start for:

-Children in Year 4 to 6 who are reading below age related expectations

Read Write Inc. Comprehension for:

- -Children in Year 2 who have graduated from RWI phonics
- -Started Autumn 2-22
- -Bridge between RWI phonics and our school's KS2 guided reading sessions (big question, vocabulary, range of text types)

Assessments:

- -half termly assessments for all
- -more regular assessments for 1A/1B/1C/Ditty groups and key children identified by teachers and reading lead
- -new starters are assessed upon arrival once they have settled
- -feedback to staff and year groups from each assessments

Additional:

- -Daily nursery rhymes in N-Y
- -Cultural capital- an enormous range of high quality texts available to the school community (Books that reflect our community)
- -RWI Phonics Mat available in every class. **Consistency across all classrooms**
- -RWI Dots/Dashes used in EYFS to support independent learning/reading in all areas.

Lowest 20% and slowest progress pupils.

1-2-1 Fast Track tutoring:

- -pupils from R-Y2 in person tutoring daily
- -pupils from Y3 up- tutoring via RWI virtual classroom (staffing)

Reception:

-Daily Fred games and Pinny time

KS1:

- -Additional daily afternoon practice
- -Use of virtual classroom

KS2:

-Additional daily practice through virtual classroom for all pupils attending RWI phonics or Fresh Start

Slowest progress pupils- those pupils who have not made progress since last assessment.

CPD:



-weekly CPD sessions- Tuesday mornings

- -training each half term-TW/Simone
- -access to portal-specific videos set up for the group we are teaching
- -coaching weekly in sessions- Reading lead
- -Development days- RWI advisor –Simone- 6 this year!
