Teaching and Learning at Salisbury Manor is firmly based on research in cognitive science and is under pinned by the Rosenshine Principles of Instruction.

Kagan structures are used in each lesson encourage cooperative learning, development of social skills and language development.

Lessons begin with
'Do Now' which
provides opportunities
to recall previously
taught content and
make an immediate

start to learning as they enter the classroom.

Pupils are introduced to **contextual vocabulary** that links to future learning

Challenge is planned into all lessons.
Children of all abilities are stretched ensuring high expectations for all learners.

Teaching is responsive:

teachers identify what students have understood and where they are struggling, and adapt their teaching. Teachers present learning in **Small Steps** and only proceed to the next step once the previous steps have been mastered.

Assessment Point (also known as Hinge Point Questions) are used to assess whether children are able to independently access the work. These are usually MCQ to ensure assessment is prompt. Teachers provide additional models and support if required.
